

Listening Game Rules

1. Our language parent will only be using their language, no English.
2. Everyone will do the actions as they are able.
3. The learner's job is to point quickly and boldly.
4. The learner will go fast and be wrong sometimes.
5. Group points or does the action a few times together, then one by one.
6. This is a listening game, so we won't be saying anything.
7. It is the learner's job to choose the games and prepare the materials.
8. When we get it wrong, the language parent will say something in her language like 'You are jumping. Walk!' "That is a dog. Where is the horse?"
9. When we get it right, the language parent will say something encouraging to us in their language, like "Good job!" This could be what a parent in that culture would say to their child.
10. Start with 2 items or actions, the learner adds one at a time.
11. The newest word gets the most random repetitions, at least 3 before moving on.
12. This game has lots of mixed up, random repetition.
13. If there are two things that learners are confusing, a learner will isolate just those two items for a little while.
14. The last round of the game, when the last word has been added, the learners will start the recording.
15. Have fun and encourage one another!
